The Mayo Clinic brings millions of visitors to Rochester each year, making it the backbone of the city's health-care and IT-driven economy, which also includes agriculture and food manufacturing. Businesses benefit from great transportation assets, too, including an airport and three U.S. highways.



Agriculture and Food Manufacturing

Seneca Foods operates a million-square-foot facility in Rochester that cans fruits and vegetables, including corn, carrots and green beans. **Kemps** (pictured), a farmer-owned cooperative, produces milk, cottage cheese, sour cream, yogurt, ice cream, frozen yogurt and dozens of novelty treats. **Reichel Foods** – which manufactures snack foods, including its popular line of Dippin' Stix products – has its corporate headquarters in Rochester.
